CODE OF CONDUCT

Members and Associates may have their rights suspended, or be expelled from Clark Fork Valley Tea Party by a vote of the Clark Fork Valley Tea Party Governing Board of Administrators.

Causes warranting suspension or expulsion include, but are not limited to: members not meeting the requirements of Clark Fork Valley Tea Party Membership, actions contrary to the Statement of Purpose, failure to comply with the By-Laws of Clark Fork Valley Tea Party, fraud, felony conviction, corruption, conflict of interest, or other actions that harm the interests, independence or good name of Clark Fork Valley Tea Party, including expressing personal views as those being authorized by the Clark Fork Valley Tea Party. Members are encouraged not to discuss Clark Fork Valley Tea Party business with any non-members.

Persons expelled may not be reconsidered for Clark Fork Valley Tea Party membership for at least one year.
